



Lights Required for Wednesday

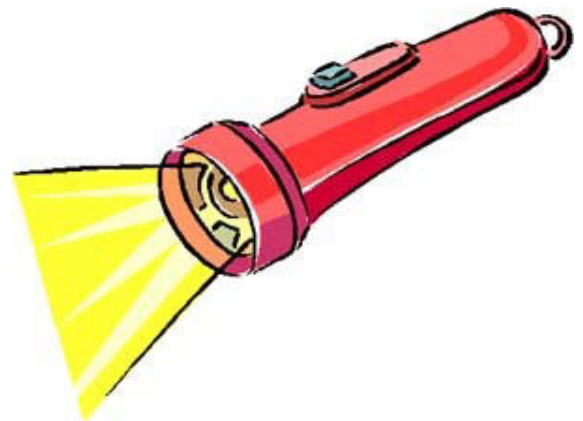
Now that daylight saving has ended, lights are required for the Wednesday night races.

The light doesn't need to be powerful - just enough so other people can see you and avoid a collision.

A simple bike light clipped to the front of your buoyancy aid or small torch taped to the bow will suffice.

Maritime requirement is for all vessels, whether motorised or man-powered, to display a steady white light visible at all times when on the water.

Collision avoidance becomes the responsibility of anyone not complying, not the other way around.



If you don't have a light you can't be seen.

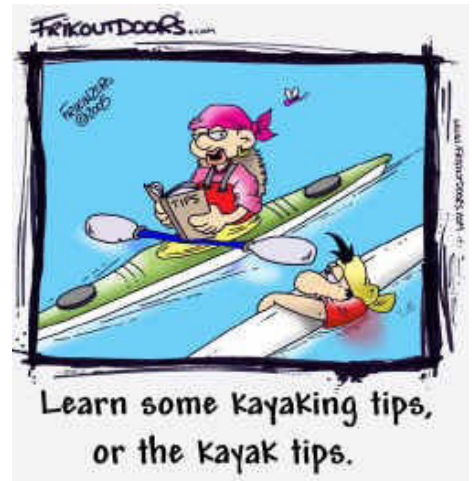
