Tuakau to Mercer

Saturday 8th May

There was a good turnout of racers for the Sunset Coast Multisport Club's 2nd running of this kayak and rowing race. This year there were excellent conditions for the race which was a relief after high wind last year.

Previously this race has been run by Auckland Canoe Club, but was revived by Club member Adrian Davis looking for a challenging, scenic race in the area to complement the Steelman Iron Maiden Event (20 Nov10) and other smaller multisport events. The event is open to all manually propelled craft. This year kayakers, rowers and surf ski racers took part.

There were 2 starts, women and men, with the harder leg to Mercer upstream where the kayakers kept close to the side to avoid the current. This entailed some rapid direction changes in shallows leading to a couple of close calls with the rowers who are more restricted in their line.

Top results were by Andrew Newick from Waitemata Canoe and Multisport Club in a K1 kayak, followed by Neil Pollock in a single rowing skiff, from Mercer Rowing Club. Louise Mark 7th overall had a clear margin in the ladies class and Sean Murphy second K1 (3rd overall) and Nathan Livingston (4th overall) first multisport man all from Waitemata Canoe and Multisport Club. Other local racers were Adrian Davis, 6th overall, Graeme Fausett 13th overall, Wally James 17th overall.

This year there was support from the Tuakau Hotel where the landlord Neil Young hosted the prize giving and presented the top spot prize of a \$100 voucher, won by Mike Conza.
